WHITE WINES

Alverdi, Pinot Grigio, Terre Degli Osci, Italy 9/32
Fresh and dry with floral notes of acacia flowers.

Casas Patronales, Sauvignon Blanc, Maule, Chile 9/32
Pale straw in color and reveals intense aromas of pineapple, peach, and citrus notes.

Straphanger, Chardonnay, Central Coast, California 9/32
Light straw color, with a simple, unassuming bouquet of citrus and vanilla.
Light and clean, with a nice finish.

Valckenberg, Gewurztraminer, Pfalz, Germany 47
A full-bodied, medium-dry wine with notes of lychee, peach, nutmeg, clove, and cinnamon with a refreshing finish.

Foppiano, Sauvignon Blanc, Russian River, California 56
An invigorating wine with lively acidity and loads of citrus fruit.
Aromas of green grass and lime give way to subtle flavors of dried apricot, vibrant Meyer lemon and lime zest on the palate.

Lander Jenkins, Chardonnay, California 52
Baked apple pie with cinnamon and vanilla on the nose, crisp acidity with citrus notes on the palate with a soft, slightly creamy finish.

RED WINES

J.W. Morris, Merlot, California 8/30
A fruit forward wine with rich berry aromas and rounded out with notes of mocha and vanilla bean.

Leese Fitch, Pinot Noir, California 9/33
Deep plum in color with an exotic nose of raspberry jam and herbs.
Medium acidity with strawberry, fig and hints of wild mushroom.

Laya, Grenache, Spain 9/33
A nose of blueberries and dark cherries. Medium bodied palate with layers of succulent black fruit entwined with French oak.

Mettler, Cabernet Sauvignon, Lodi, California 62
Aromas of dark cherry, cedar and earth. Smooth, medium bodied palate with soft tannins, dark chocolate, black currant, dark cherry, and toasty vanilla.

Calista, Pinot Noir, The Coast Range, California 59
Deep ruby red in color with aromatics of dried cherries, rose petals, violet, and roasted coffee. This wine finishes with dark fruit and black tea.

Red Knot, Shiraz, McLaren Vale, Australia 54
Deep red with purple hues. Primary aromas of ripe, sweet strawberry and blackberry are laced with notes of summer roses and hazelnut milk chocolate. Luscious dark berry fruits flow across the palate and are channeled into the long, lingering finish by soft, chewy tannins and a fine minerality.

SPARKLING & CHAMPAGNE

LaLuca Prosecco, Veneto, Italy 9/32
The nose is instantly defined and distinctive, offering up bold orchard fruits, crisp pears, and lemon curd, all of which come together in a rich, creamy off-dry style.

Veuve Clicquot, Reims, France 160
A full-bodied, rich, deep champagne with ripe apple flavours. The nose begins with fruity notes reminiscent of pear flesh, with discreet biscuity notes in the background. The palate is clean and fresh with a fine texture.
